The church we see is a place of influence, so large its heartbeat is felt across the nations, and yet within it, so small that all find a family.

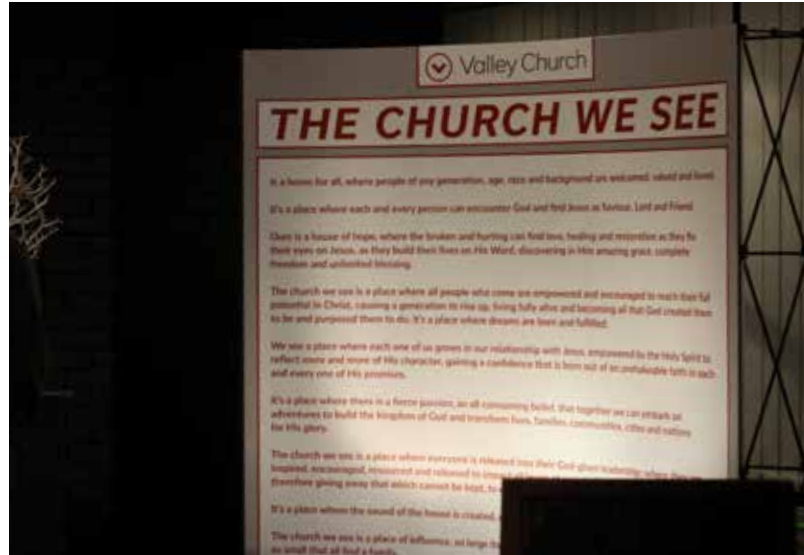
WELCOME HOME

Course Outline

There are six key elements to the Year-In Programme. Our hope is that you will receive a well-rounded theoretical and practical application of all of the topics covered across the year. Each element is designed to stretch and challenge you in order to help you reach your greatest potential.

- You will be assigned to work alongside and intern for one of our staff so that you can learn and glean from them as you help them in the areas of ministry they're involved with.
- You will receive lectures, write coursework and prepare presentations within your academic work.
- We will provide you with opportunities to deepen your spiritual life through focused study, journaling and personal prayer and devotion to God.
- We hope to identify your skills (both obvious and undiscovered) and then help you become stronger in them practically.
- Servanthood is about building character by getting stuck into whatever is needed to help build the church, whether it's cleaning toilets, setting up for conferencing, or simply helping a volunteer with one of their tasks.
- We will provide you with a mentor who is part of our congregation, but not working within our staff team, so that you can get a full range of experience being poured into your life.
